Salon: *A gathering of people under the roof of an inspiring host, partly to amuse one another and partly to refine their taste and increase their knowledge through conversation. These gatherings often consciously following Horace's definition of the aims of poetry, "either to please or to educate" ("aut delectare aut prodesse est"). The salons, commonly associated with French literary and philosophical salons of the 17th century and 18th century, were carried on until quite recently in urban settings among like-minded people of a 'set': many 20th-century salons could be instanced.*

Who: You..... artists of all sorts, and art appreciators, friends of art and artists.

What: It's an informal gathering of people who want to share their art or people who just want to appreciate it. You are not required to bring a piece of art.
